SCHOLARSHIP	ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA
<input type="checkbox"/> Birks Family Foundation Scholarship	➤ Open to all eligible baccalaureate nursing students. “Established by the Birks Family Foundation out of an interest in contributing to a higher standard of living and quality of life by supporting higher education, the hospital sector, and health organizations”
<input type="checkbox"/> Canadian Nurses Foundation Scholarship	➤ Open to all eligible baccalaureate nursing students.
<input type="checkbox"/> Johnson & Johnson Scholarship	➤ Students who plan to practice nursing in an operating room or a critical care area.
<input type="checkbox"/> Judy Hill Scholarship	➤ Students who have worked in the north or who will signed a statement that they will practice nursing in the north for a period of 12 months.
<input type="checkbox"/> John Vanderlee Scholarship	➤ Male nursing students only.
<input type="checkbox"/> Margaret Munro Scholarship	➤ Students from Prince Edward Island only.
<input type="checkbox"/> Nova Scotia Nurses Scholarship	➤ Members of the College of Registered Nurses of Nova Scotia only.
